### HOW TO APPLY

All candidates are asked to submit a personal statement, GCSE predicted grades and invited for interview with our teaching staff. The Application Form should be submitted no later than 8 February 2021, with accompanying personal statement.

#### **Step 1**

#### **Step 2**

Submit a personal statement and predicted grades to [admissions@brightongirls.gdst.net](mailto:admissions@brightongirls.gdst.net)

#### **Step 3**

Before an interview we will contact the applicant's current school for a reference.

#### **Step 4**

Interview and offer. Conditional offers are made in March conditional upon GCSE grades achieved and released the following August. Upon acceptance of a conditional offer students are invited in to a series of Sixth Form Induction Days held at the end of our Summer Term.

### CRITERIA

We accept pupils with 5 GCSEs at Grade 4 or above.

### PERSONAL STATEMENT

We ask all applicants to submit a personal statement (written by the candidate) in support of their application for Brighton Girls (maximum length 500 words).
