



TEMPLE SCHOLARSHIP - SPORT - SKATEBOARD

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Sport scholarships and exhibitions are awarded to pupils showing particular promise or commitment to sports as part of our Temple Scholarship Awards. Candidates applying for a Sport Skateboard Scholarship would preferably have experience in a variety of sports, with Skateboarding as their lead sport. We are interested in girls who perform at a high level (at least club level) in a variety of sports including: Athletics, Gymnastics, Hockey, Netball, Cricket, Football and Tennis. Other sports may be considered on an individual basis.

Please note - we appreciate that this year it has been impossible for girls to undertake many extra-curricular activities - that dance, music and sports activities in particular have been affected. We will therefore be placing greater emphasis on references from teacher and clubs - and on potential rather than actual grades.

HOW AWARDS ARE ASSESSED

Scholarships are awarded on the strength of the practical assessment session, as well as the personal statement and recommendations submitted. The results of the Brighton Girls Entrance Examinations are also taken into consideration.

Girls will be invited to participate in an assessment session run by with our Skateboard Coach

All aspects of an individual's performance will be considered during the session, such as ability, attitude and enthusiasm

The session will conclude with a short interview.

HOW TO APPLY

The Temple Sport Skateboard Scholarship Application Form should be submitted with accompanying references from sports coaches or from a candidate's current school.

SPORTS (SKATEBOARD) AWARD HOLDERS' RESPONSIBILITIES

The Sports Department undertakes to provide a first-rate education. We hope that each award holder will recognise the many opportunities offered and will respond positively and with enthusiasm. A girl receiving a Scholarship for Sport (Skateboard) will be expected to represent the School and be a proactive member of our co-curricular programme. It is our hope that award holders will, in time, become leaders in the sporting life of the school.

NEXT STEPS

Applicants will be invited to a meeting with our Skateboard Coach and Head.

Temple Scholarship - up to 3 areas may be applied for.

The School's decision on awards is final.
